Child Care and Expanded Learning for Children 0-12 Years Old

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- Licensure requirements
- Strong quality measurement infrastructure and state defined quality standards
- Widely diverse mixed-delivery systems ranging from family child care to center based care
- Deeper caregiver and family focus
- Serve very young children with lower ratios

Overlap Between Systems

- Stronger link to school day/year;
 majority school-based
- Serves majority older youth with higher ratios
- State defined quality standards
- Majority part-time workforce; unclear career pathways

ECE

- Serves TK, K, school aged kids
- Support working families outside of the traditional school day/calendar
- Prioritize the most underserved communities and families
- Operated by a diverse and community-grounded workforce
- Experts in child and youth development
- Operate in a range of school, community, and private partnership models and learning environments
- Dosage and quality matters to outcomes
- Low wage/compensation/benefit employment major staffing shortages


