Education

- Licensure requirements
- Strong quality measurement infrastructure and state defined quality standards
- Widely diverse mixed-delivery systems ranging from family child care to center based care
- Deeper caregiver and family focus
- Serve very young children with lower ratios

**ECE**

**Overlap  
Between Systems**

- Serves TK, K, school aged kids
- Support working families outside of the traditional school day/calendar
- Prioritize the most underserved communities and families
- Operated by a diverse and community-grounded workforce
- Experts in child and youth development
- Operate in a range of school, community, and private partnership models and learning environments
- Dosage and quality matters to outcomes
- Low wage/compensation/benefit employment major staffing shortages

- Stronger link to school day/year; majority school-based
- Serves majority older youth with higher ratios
- State defined quality standards
- Majority part-time workforce; unclear career pathways

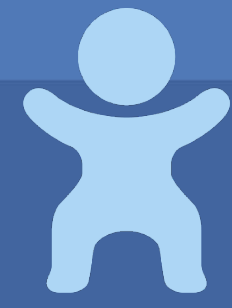

## Expanded Learning

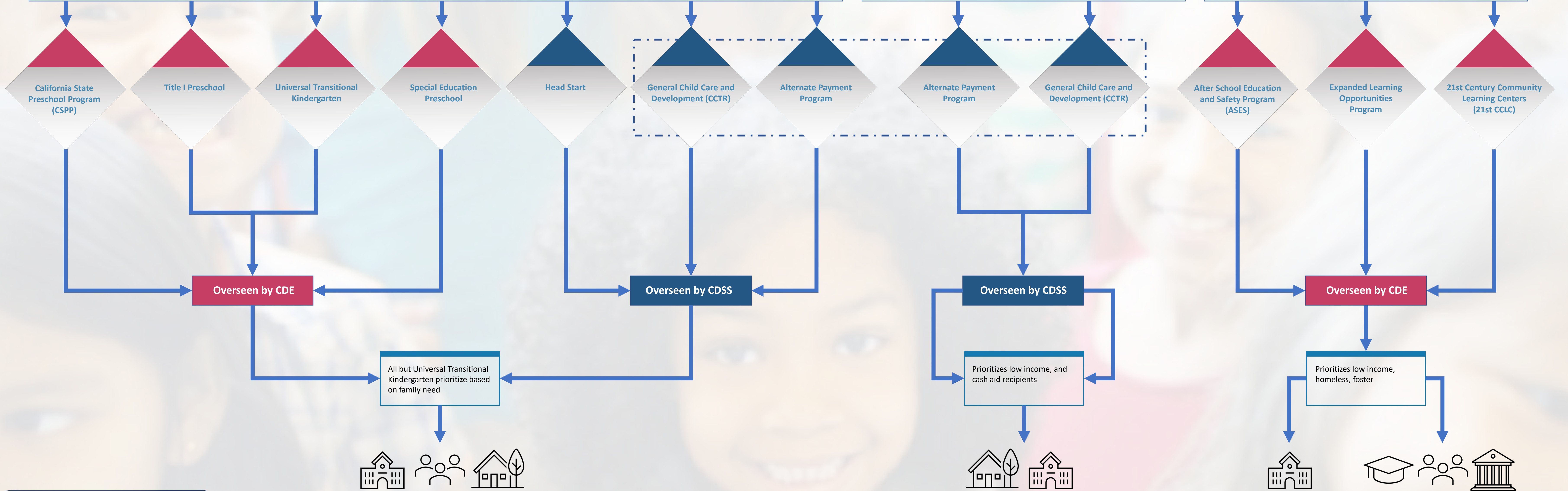


◆ Ages 4 and above ◆

**SRR:** \$47.98 per child day of enrollment or \$11,995 per annum based on 250 days of operation. **RMR:** Varies for each county and different rates apply by age and amount of care (e.g., part-time vs. full-time, monthly vs. weekly rate, etc.)

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**ASES:** \$10.18 per student per day (3 hours) for school year (180 days)  
**ELO-P:** Approximately \$9.65-11.90 per student per day for 9 hours (including instructional hours) and school year + 30 days



All but Universal Transitional Kindergarten prioritize based on family need



Settings = All the settings, school sites, centers, private residences

Prioritizes low income, and cash aid recipients



Settings = Private centers and homes, may be a school site but very limits

Prioritizes low income, homeless, foster



Settings = School sites

Types of providers = Local Education Agencies (grantee), Community-Based Organizations, Municipal agencies
